

A new year is upon us. I am looking forward to a new year with Virginia AWHONN. Throughout 2014, we will be "In the Pursuit of Excellence." The mission of AWHONN to promote the health of women and newborns will continue.

I am looking forward to a great year as we pursue excellence. I have been made aware of several regional and chapter conferences and symposiums that will be held throughout the section, please visit our website for more information. The AWHONN National Conference will be held in Orlando, Florida in June. This is a great event for learning, networking, and socializing. This year, the Virginia Section will host its annual conference in Fredericksburg, Virginia, on September 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014. It will be a grand time.

We are planning new services that should be available to Virginia members soon. Our website now hosts an employment section that will allow for posting of employment opportunities across the section. In addition, soon we will have a Webinar Library available to all members which will assist in continuing education.



The Virginia Section of AWHONN was a winner of the *Giving Tuesday* fundraising contest for the *Every Woman, Every Baby* Campaign and was awarded a Breastfeeding Evidence Based Guideline. This Guideline will be available to all chapters for membership education.

A year ago, I put forth these goals for the next two years:

- Increase our membership by 20%. This would put us at 1000 members strong to promote the issues of women and children throughout Virginia.
- Establish partnerships within the communities from schools of nursing, retailors, financial institutions, and community services to draw on their resources and to promote our mission.
- Increase the public's awareness of Virginia AWHONN.

Our *One Women, One Newborn, One Thousand Strong* Campaign is still being waged. Our numbers peaked to almost 900 members during 2013 but had a down turn to the present level of 835 members. At 835 members, we are only 165 members away from our goal of 1000 members strong. I am asking all members to encourage any non-member to join AWHONN and reap the benefits of being part of their professional organization. Members that recruit 3 new members in a calendar year will receive a one-year free membership along with other prizes (log on to www.awhonn.org for more information).

VA AWHONN has begun to increase its public awareness around the state. We have started sending a representative to regional meetings, conferences, and symposiums. We are establishing partnerships with other Sections, financial institutions, and schools of nursing. We look forward to more work in the future with other professional organizations.

On behalf of all the leaders of Virginia AWHONN, we look forward to a great year working with you as we are "In Pursuit of Excellence" and promoting the health of women and newborns.
